Subject to the following conditions:

1. The Permittee shall be responsible for fires authorized by this permit and shall be liable for all damages caused by him, or others, while acting under this permit.
2. The Permittee shall provide at the site during light-up and for safeguarding the fires authorized by this permit, an adequate adult person(s) suitably equipped to effectively safeguard the fires.
3. No fires to be lit prior to sunrise of each day. Any existing fire(s) remaining from previous day will be attended until out, or reasonable time of 11:00pm as specified below.
4. The Permittee shall employ the safeguarding forces to actively mop-up and extinguish the fires authorized by this permit as soon as possible after the fires have been reduced to a smouldering state.
5. No fires to be lit or rekindled when winds exceed 40 kph.
6. The Permittee shall ensure that material to be burned is a minimum of 100 feet from standing timber, brush of flammable material, or 100 feet from any building.
7. The Permittee shall totally extinguish all fires authorized by this permit on or prior to expiry date of this permit; or shall extinguish them forthwith upon suspension or cancellation of this permit or when instructed to do so by an officer of the PGFD.
8. When the main burn has been completed, as soon as possible thereafter, all smouldering spots must be extinguished.
9. No fires to be burning between the hours of sunset and sunrise without approval of PGFD.
10. All materials to be burned must be piled, and the area of said piles must not exceed _____ square feet.
11. Burn shall not exceed 200 feet in length with a break of 30 feet in width.
12. The Permittee shall also abide by additional written conditions attached to this permit.
