## INVITATION TO ALL PRINCE GEORGE RESIDENTS

### **Catch a Rainbow Trout at Shane Lake On Thursday, June 25, from 10 am to 11 am**

The Northern BC Sportfishing Task Force and the City of Prince George is hosting a ceremony at Shane Lake to celebrate a brand new "Family Fishing Waters" within the City of Prince George. Bring your family, friends and fishing rods to watch the lake get stocked with Rainbow Trout that are ready to be caught on Thursday, June 25th, from 10am – 11am.

Fishing Licenses will be required.

Shane Lake has been chosen as a suitable urban lake to develop a recreational fishery for local residents and tourists for a one year trial. This lake will become part of the Province's "Family Fishing Waters", providing easy access to sport fishing opportunities within the city. The Shane Lake project is part of a larger initiative to boost sport fishing participation in the region.

The Northern BC Sportfishing Task Force is comprised of more than a dozen members representing tourism associations, outdoor clubs, the Ministry of Environment, UNBC and local businesses.

Shane Lake, located in Forests for the World is only minutes from downtown Prince George.
